

The following meetings were held as informational meetings by the Zoning Commission.

- 1) November 4, 2010 at the Town Hall with the Town Board. This meeting was a power point presentation of the Draft Zoning law. The meeting was a Town Board Work Shop and had approximately 10 people there in addition to all the Board Members and Commission members.
- 2) The Zoning Commission next had a meeting on November 13, at 10 a.m. at the Acra Community Center. There were approximately 21 people in attendance not including the 5 members of the Zoning Commission.
- 3) On November 15, the Zoning Commission had another informational meeting at the Town Hall. There were approximately 40 people in attendance at this meeting plus members of the Zoning Commission.
- 4) The last informational meeting was held with the Planning Board at a Planning Board work shop on the 18th of November. There were approximately 12 people in attendance plus the Zoning Commission and Planning Board.

In Summary: The Commission generalized that 1) more time for input was necessary and 2) we have to work on all the input that was received from the community in as timely a manner as we can, and 3) the commercial issue (more commercial) has to be looked at for the community since this was a topic we heard numerous times after the informational meetings.

In response the Commission is moving the public comment from November 26, 2010 to January 10, 2011 and will spend the next meeting on the commercial properties on the maps. In addition, the Commission will also work on the individual questions that were written by community members and work through those on the internet so community members can have answers to their questions.
